Notes from ExComm:

- The date of this event will be selected alongside ExComm.
- Submission of a Year-End Bid requires the local chapter's willingness to take on full financial responsibility for the event including any profit/loss. That being the case, the ExComm will budget a small amount (no more than \$500) for any expenses incurred because of plans specific to the ExComm's obligations.
 - This bid must include an itemized budget with the cost per attendee declared.
 - Registration & Meals for Executive Committee members and any JCI USA guests must be covered. (Hotel accommodations will be covered by ExComm.)
- The Executive Committee holds the obligation for planning and scheduling all trainings, keynotes, and meeting agendas for this event but will take recommendations from the chapter.
- The traditional registration cost of \$50 is adjustable depending on the specific needs/plans of the bidding chapter. Please discuss with ExComm for approval before selecting a registration cost higher than \$50.
 - Friday/Saturday night social events need not be included in that registration cost and can be offered as an additional cost to the attendees if the host chapter sees fit to do so.
- Registration can be run through the GA Jaycees Eventbrite if the chapter wishes to do so.
